


OS 1934 1 inch map and OS 1938 6 inch map of Kempshott Village.

After the First Series OS maps , surveyed in the early years of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and printed in various editions such as shown on Greenwood's maps, no fundamental resurveying was carried out until the 1870s. Revisions were made , such as adding in the railways, but some of the errors and short-comings of the First Series remained until the major resurveying in the 1870s.





Worting and Kempshott on OS 1901 - 12 1inch map series

The area was resurveyed in the 1890s which formed the basis of the Third Edition series and revisions through to 1919.




## Worting and Kempshott on the OS 1901 – 12 6 inch map revised series
